6. CHAS Accreditation

This is fourth year that QC has achieved the CHAS accreditation process. This demonstrates our continued commitment to maintaining a high H&S level throughout the business.

7. NHBC Health & Safety Accreditation Audit

The NHBC Health & Safety Accreditation Audit was carried out in June. We have retained our 'Excellent' score, however the percentage dropped slightly from 96% to 92.9%. We still retain an 'excellent' rating.

8. QC NHBC Site Safety Awards

Cat Hill and Walthamstow Stadium both received awards in the national competition and Walthamstow Stadium received a 'Highly Commended Award' in the multi storey category.
